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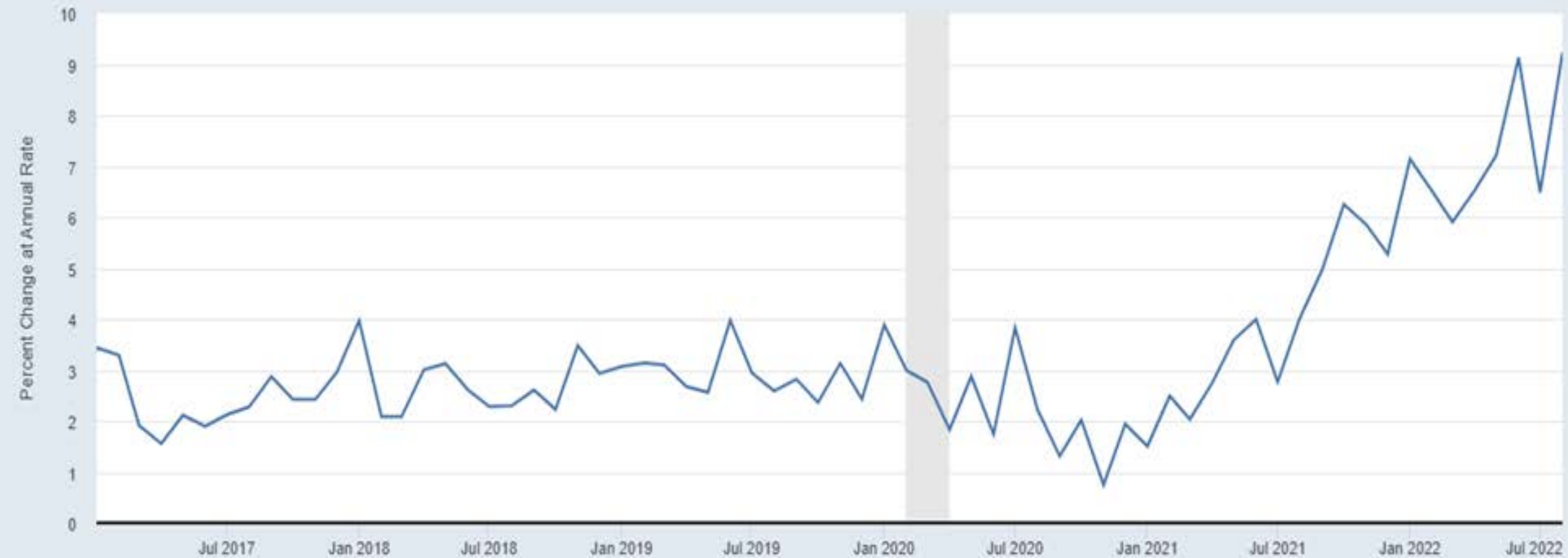

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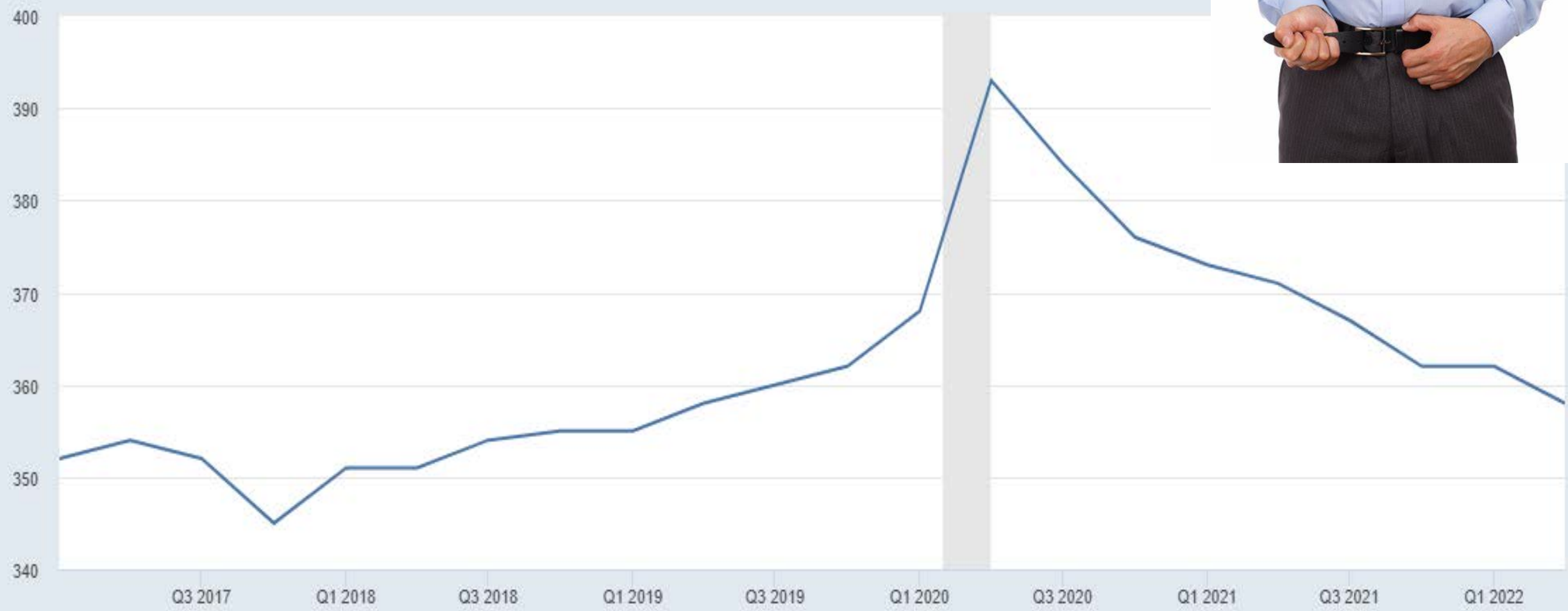


Shaded areas indicate U.S. recessions.

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1982-84 CPI Adjusted Dollars

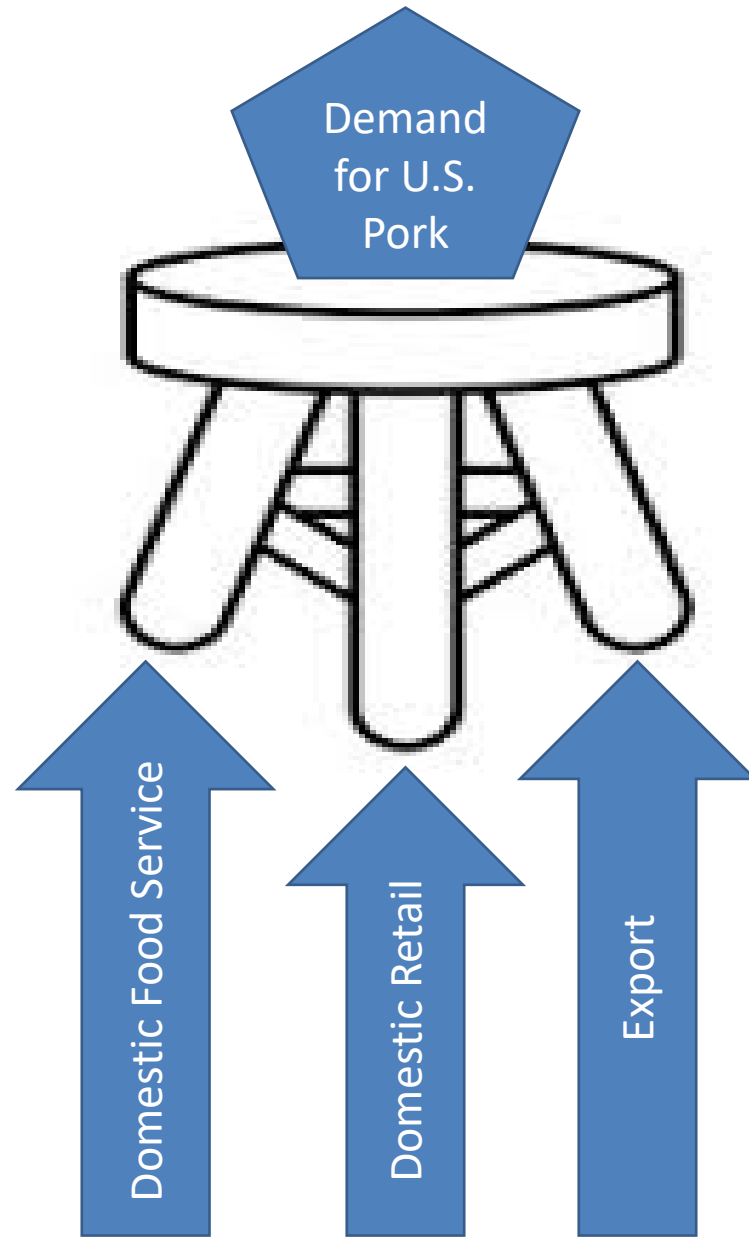

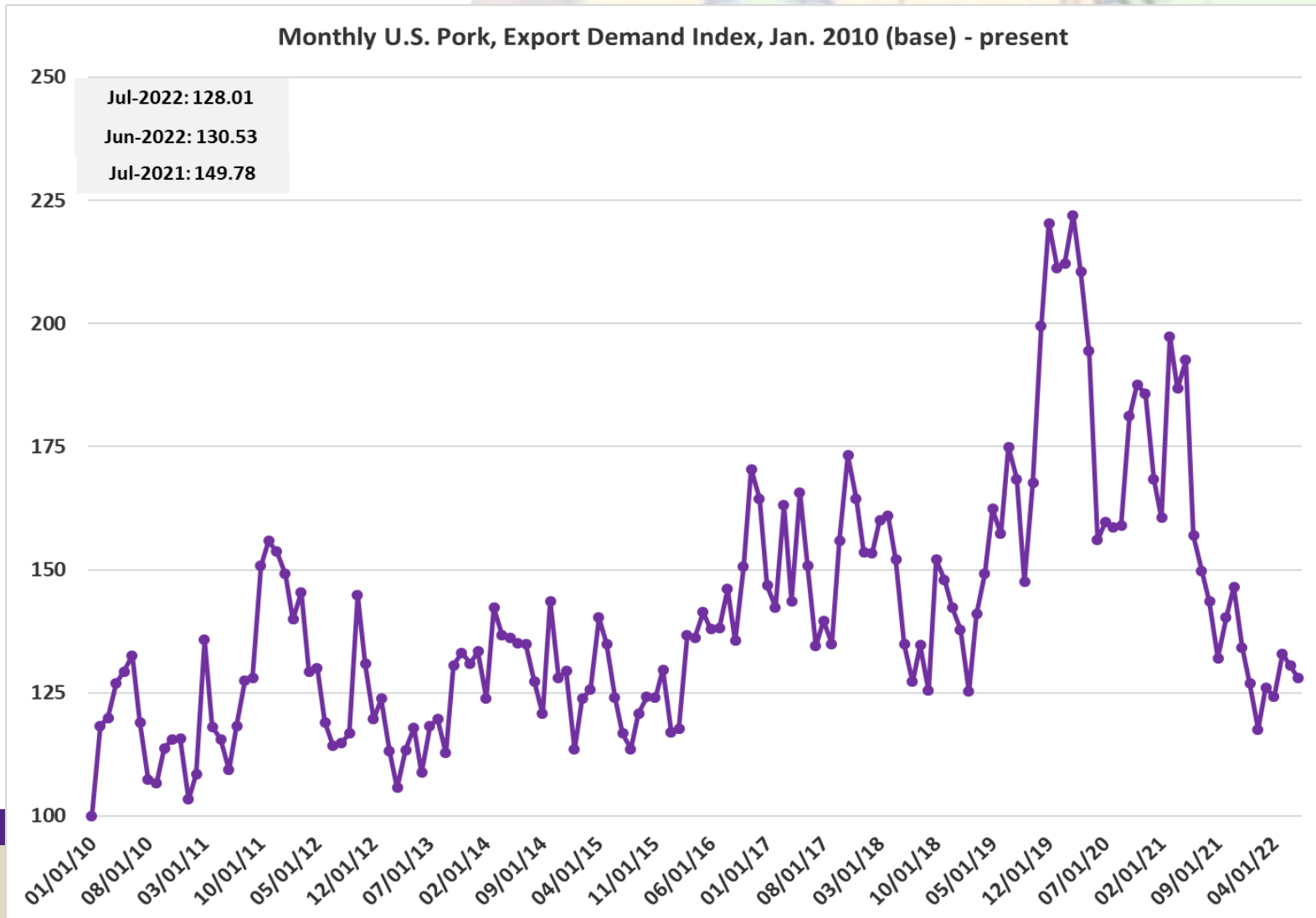
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U.S. Pork Export Demand – Peaked 3/20'

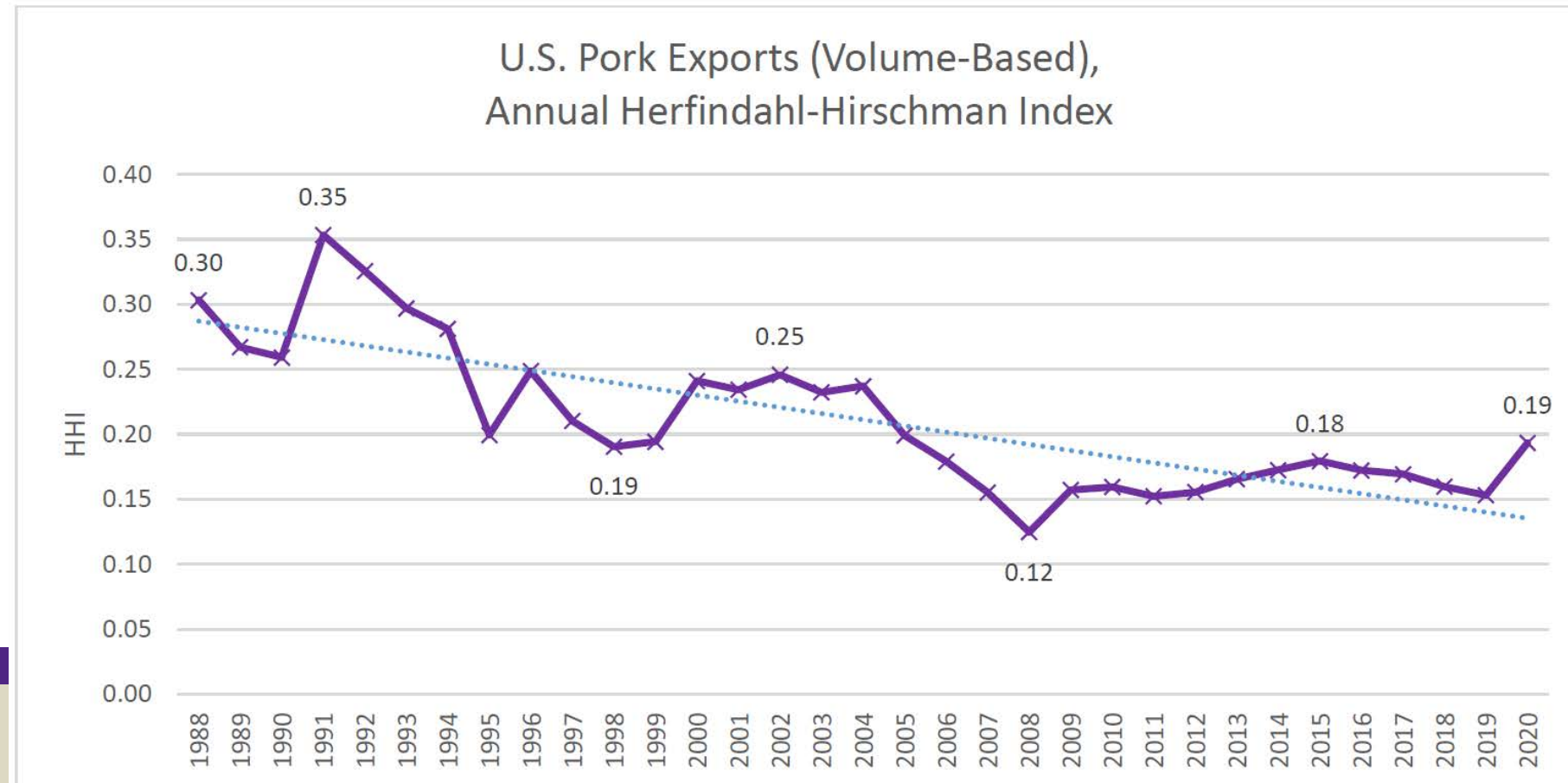

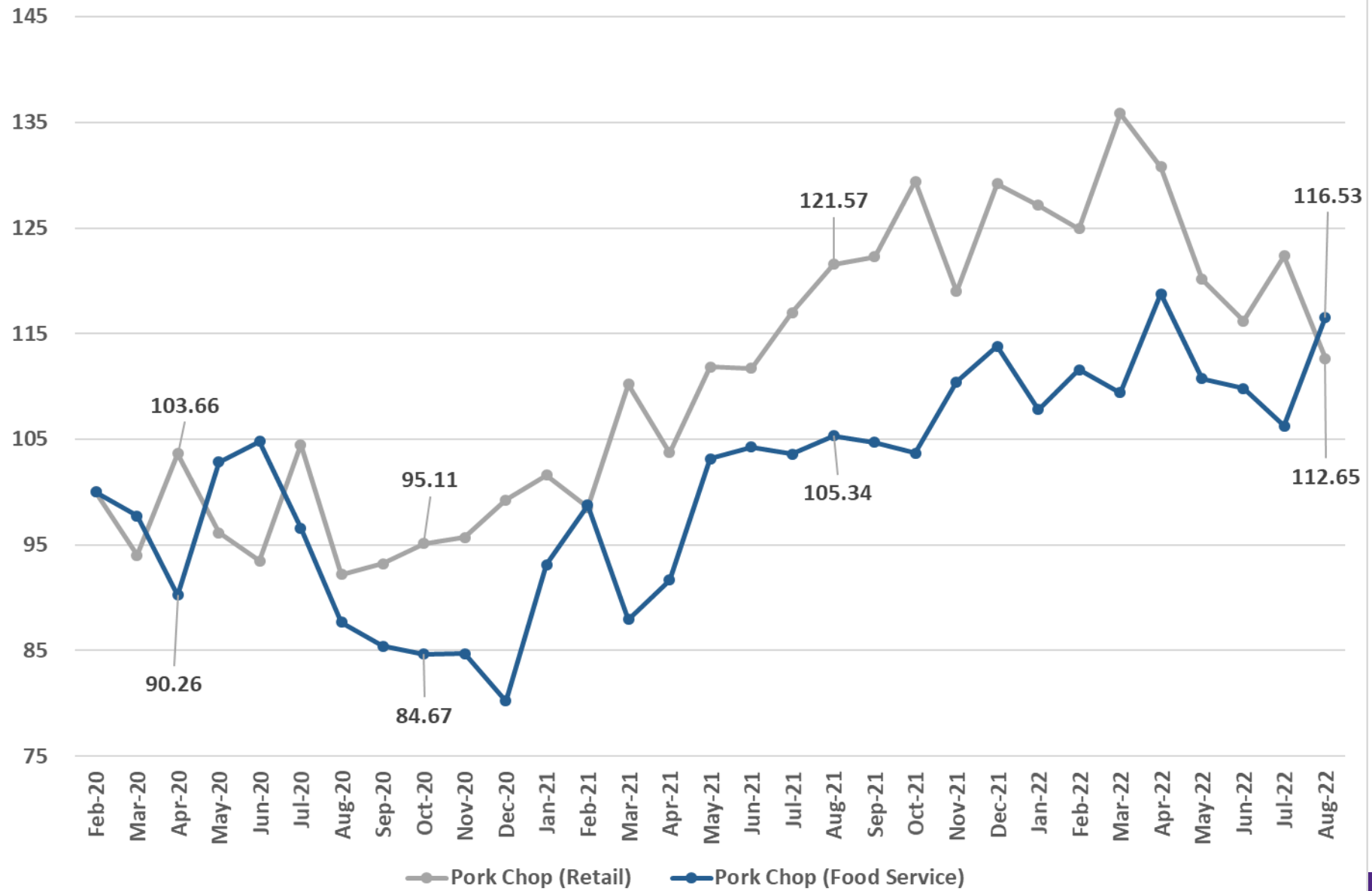

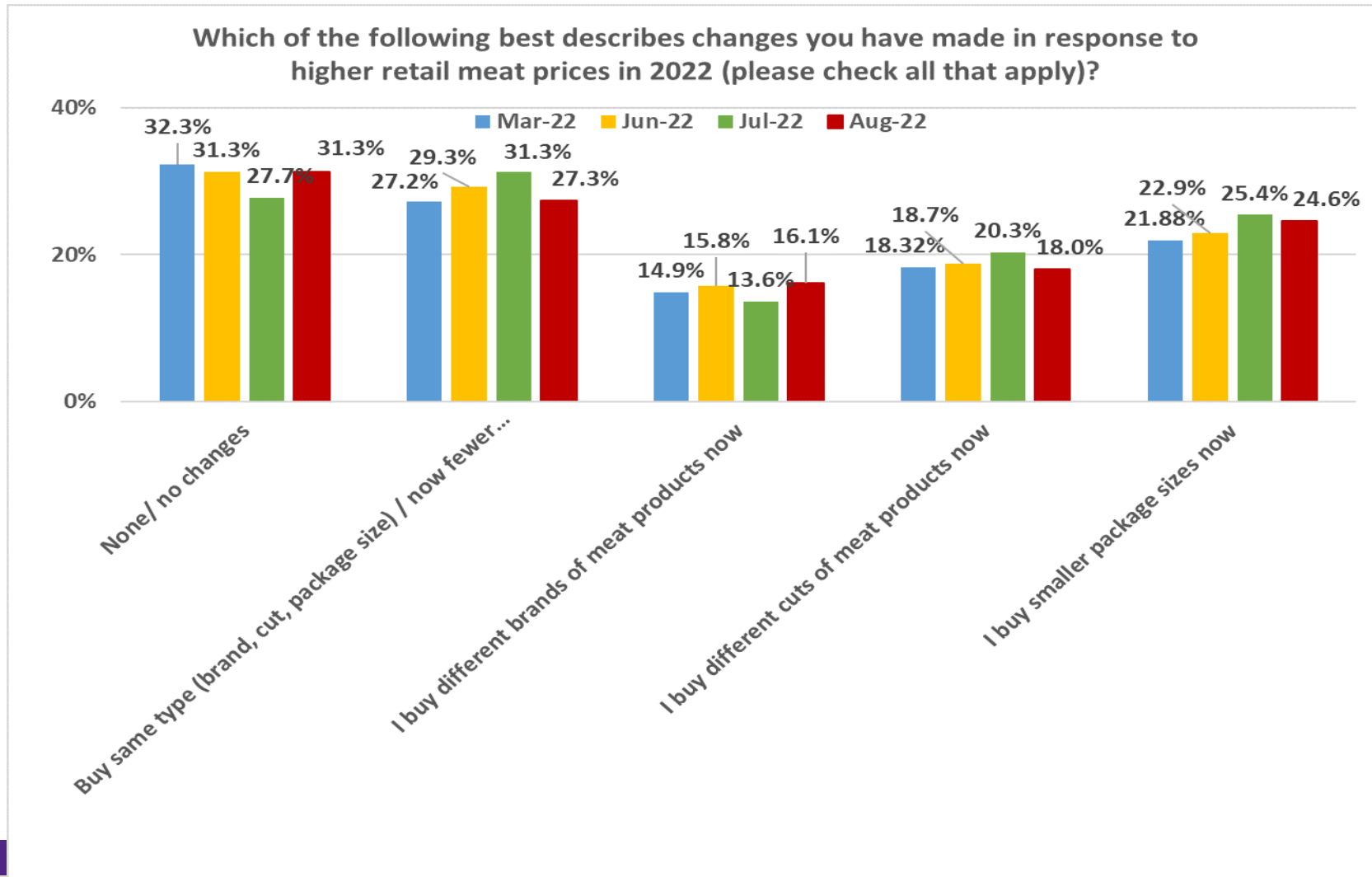

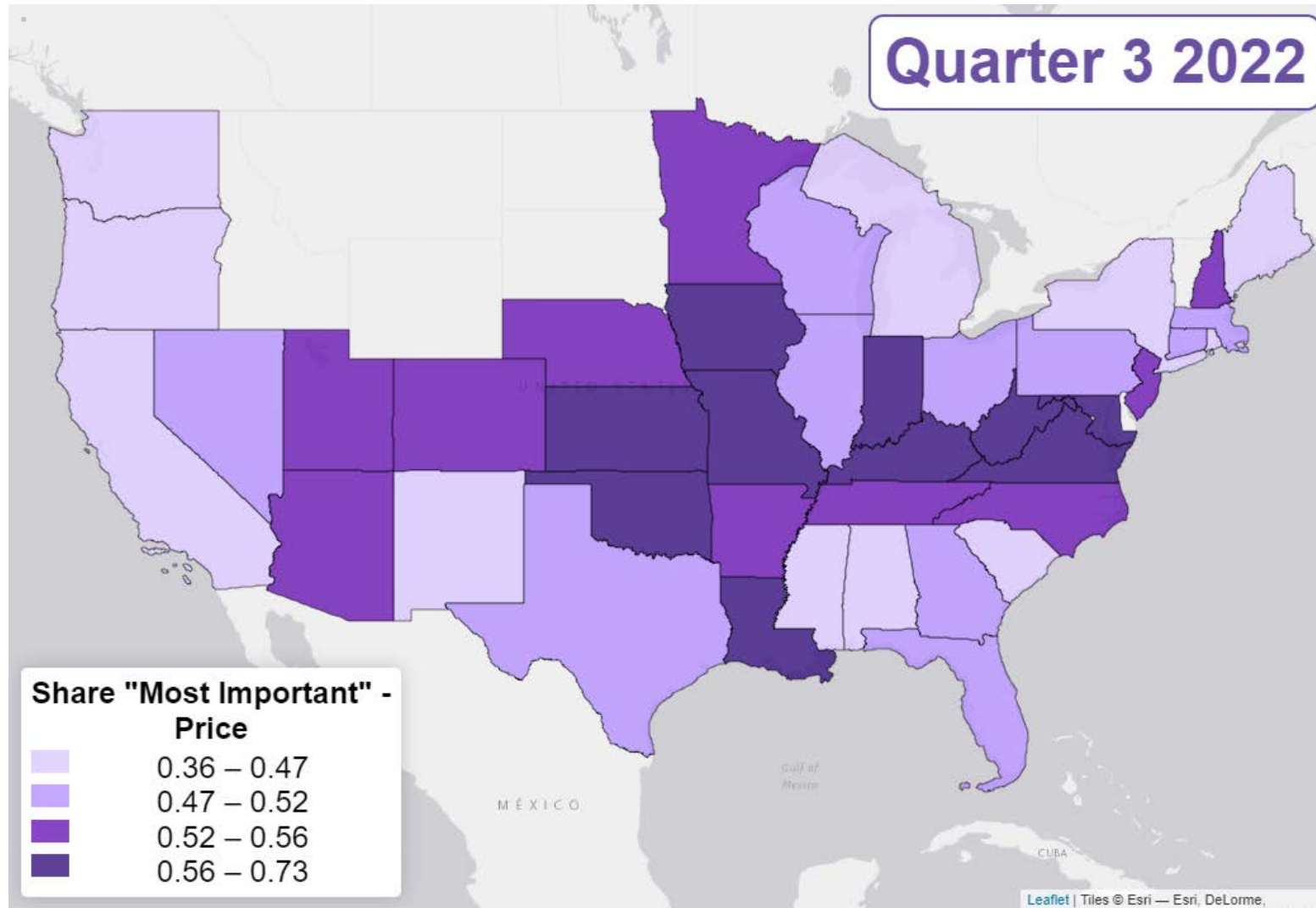


How Has Economy-Wide Inflation Impacted Consumer Sensitivity to Pork Prices?

Tonsor & Lusk, Sept 2022 – NPB Report

- ❑ Real earnings declined since Q2.2020
- ❑ Relative importance of Price (#MDM) higher in Q2.2022 than Q2.2021
- ❑ Analysis of IRI Scanner data (Jan 2017 – Aug 2022):
 - ❑ Consumers are becoming more sensitive to prices on retail pork products
 - ❑ Loin market stands out “leading” in increased price sensitivity

GT's 2023 Punchline

1. Export demand could grow **IF** USD weakens & foreign economies hold-up
2. Domestic demand is mixed story
 - Ongoing , general desire for protein is supportive (*Meat Demand Outdoes Meat Avoidance!*)
 - Yet, ongoing macroeconomic challenges are increasingly weighing on consumer buying power

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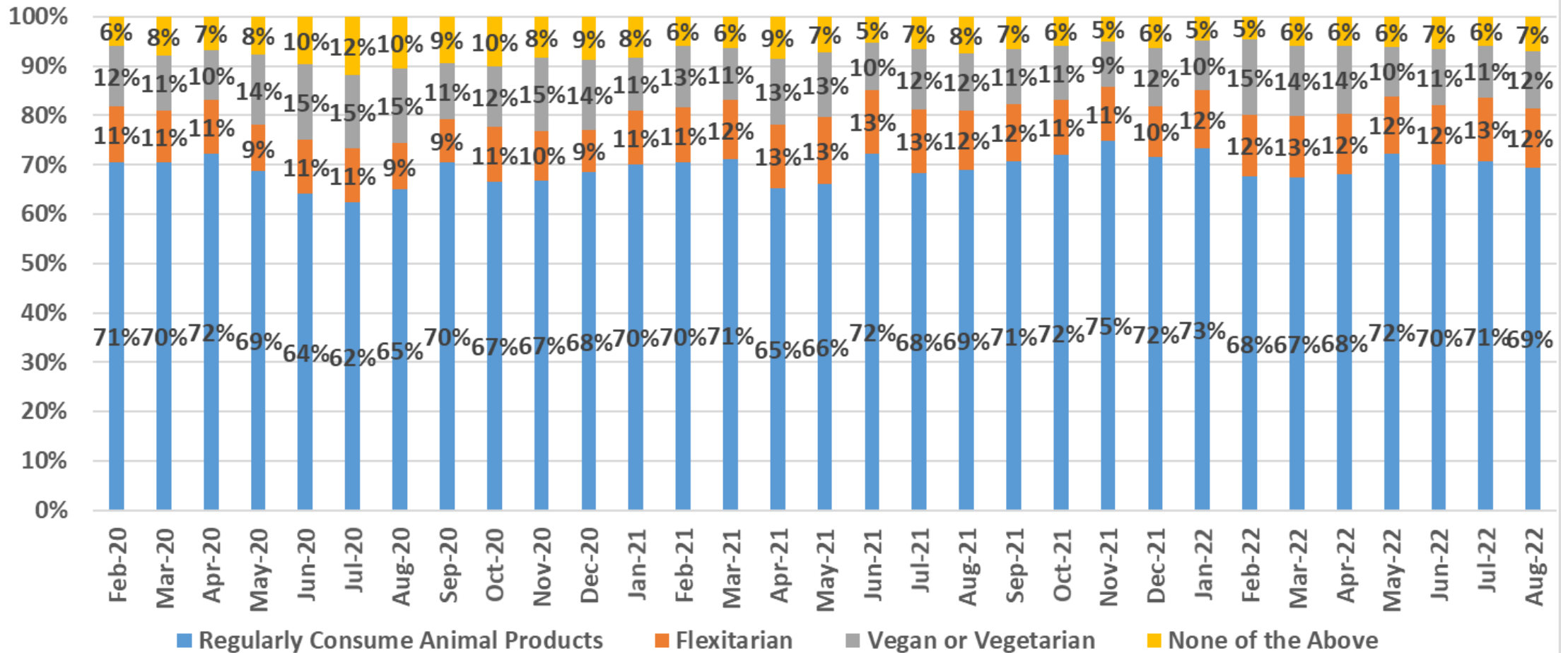
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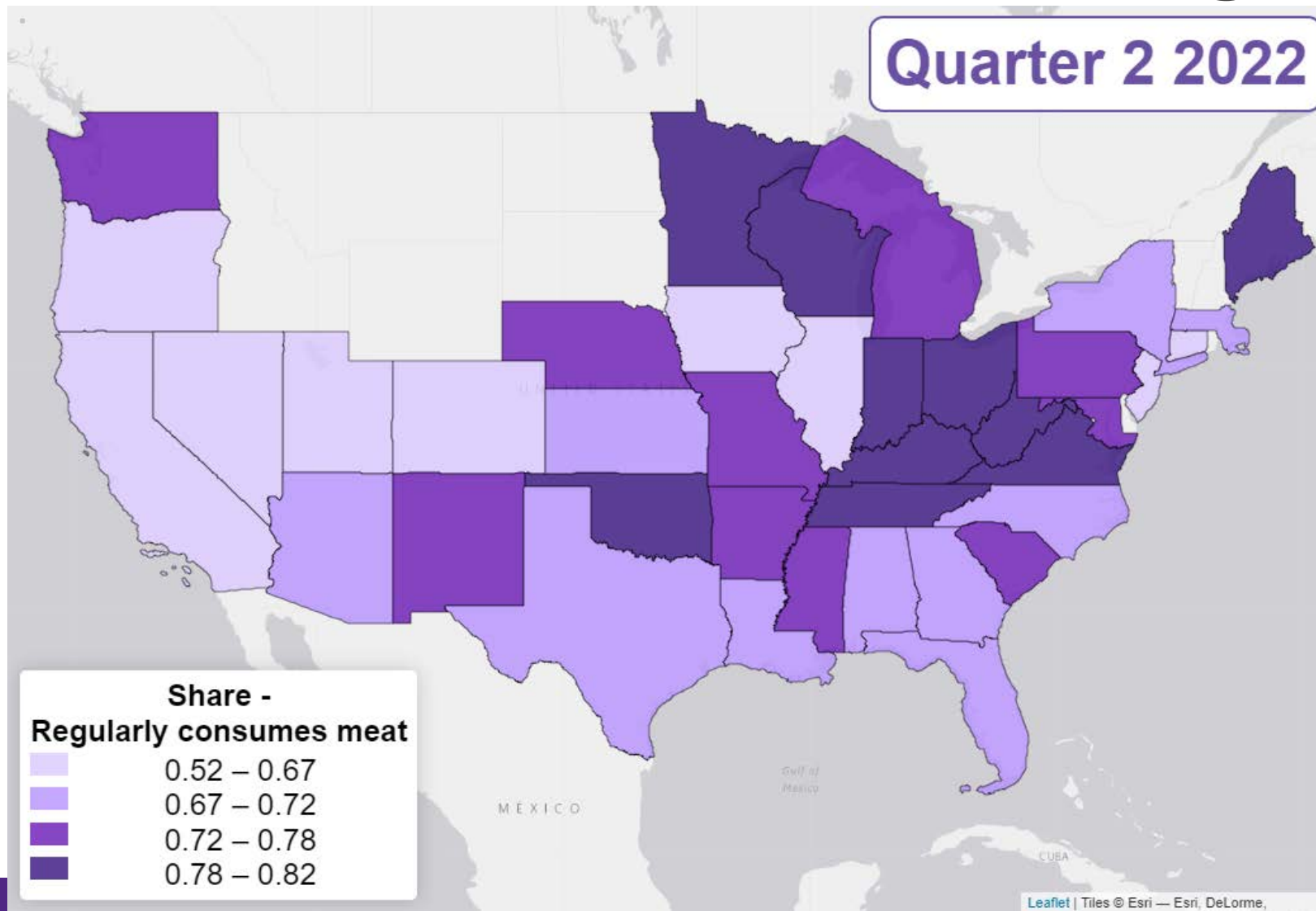

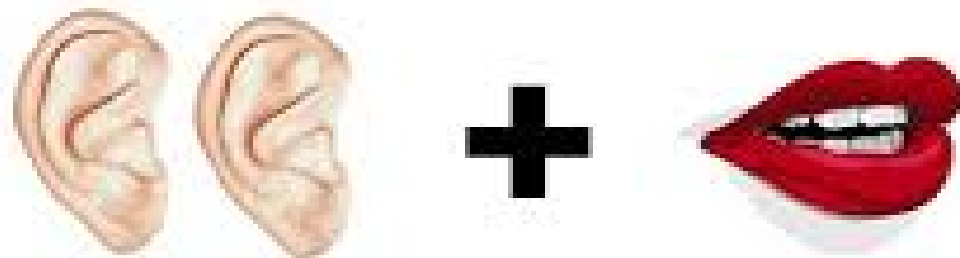
